

## **Cookie policy for <https://cambornecommunitychurch.org.uk/>**

This website uses cookies. By using this website and agreeing to this policy, you consent to Camborne Community Church's use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy.

Cookies are files sent by web servers to web browsers and stored by the web browsers. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. These cookies are used to store information, such as the time that the current visit occurred, whether the visitor has been to the site before and what site referred the visitor to the web page. The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

There are two main kinds of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your computer when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

Camborne Community Church may collect information about your computer, including your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and in order to create reports. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns and does not identify any individual.

- Google (Analytics, DoubleClick and YouTube)
- Snazzymaps

#### **Concrete5**

The Concrete5 session cookie simply checks whether the current user is a website editor/administrator and if so, whether they are logged into the site or not.

#### **Google**

Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store and use this information. In **Internet Explorer/Edge** you can refuse all cookies by clicking "Tools", "Internet Options", "Privacy", and selecting "Block all cookies" using the sliding selector.

In **Firefox**, you can adjust your cookies settings by clicking "Tools", "Options" and "Privacy".
